



### Tax coupons to become obsolete

Effective 1/1/2011 the IRS (US Department of Treasury) will no longer be accepting paper Form 8109 federal tax coupons. This means that if you have taxes to deposit, you will need to deposit them electronically. Taxes currently accepted with Form 8109 include: payroll taxes (940, 941, 944 or 945), income or estimated taxes (1120 or 990-T), and excise taxes (720, 990, and 990-PF). Taxpayers who do not pay electronically could incur a 10% failure-to-deposit penalty.
